THE CAMPUS

The School is purpose built with a design that supports a balanced curriculum. The Gardens Campus which houses Elementary and Secondary, has technology equipped classrooms, science laboratories, a design and technology hub, two library media centers, two indoor gymnasiums, two performance theatres, outdoor basketball and tennis courts, an outdoor swimming pool and soccer pitch. 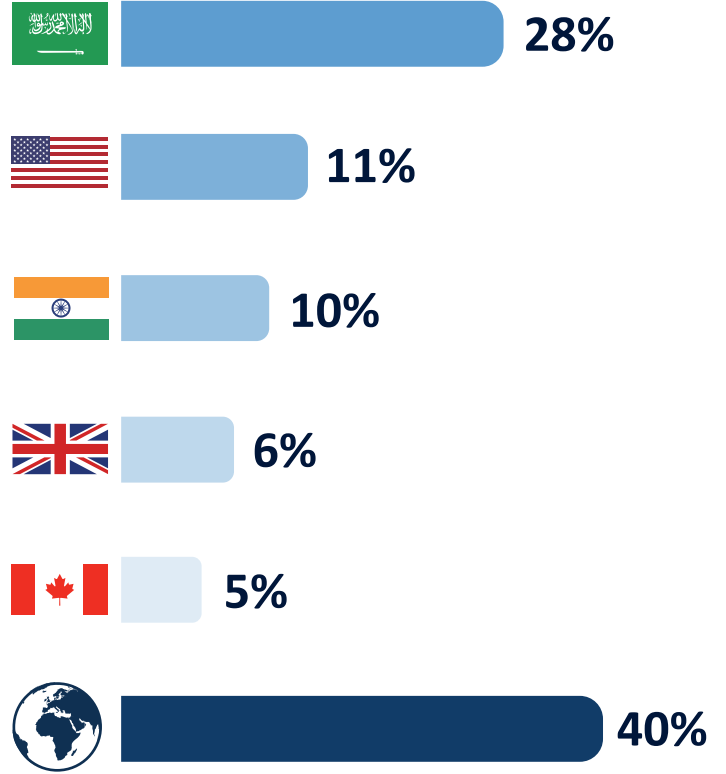

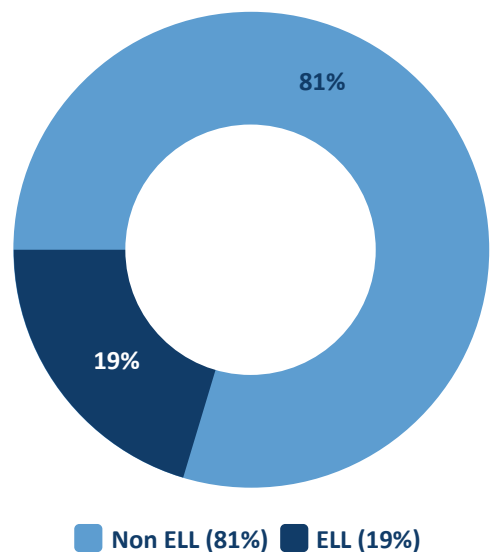

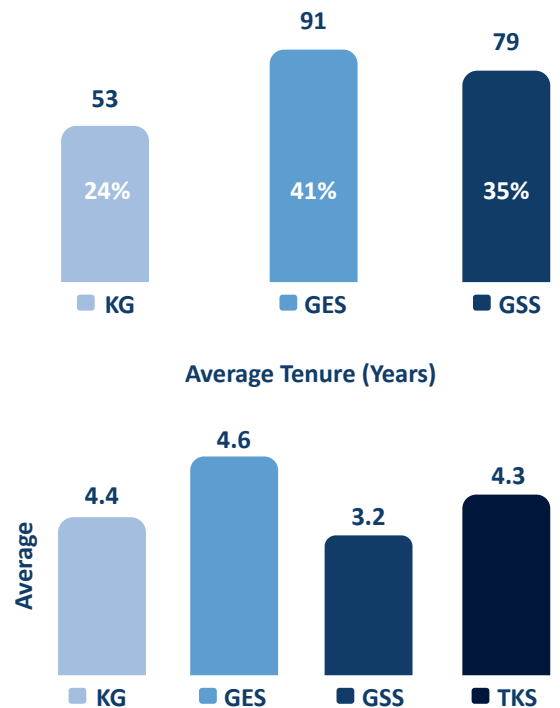


Years of Service*

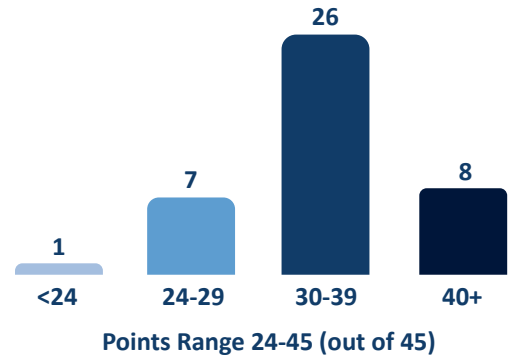

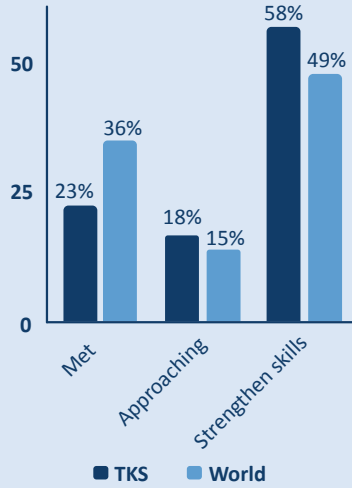

Evidence Based Reading and Writing Benchmarks

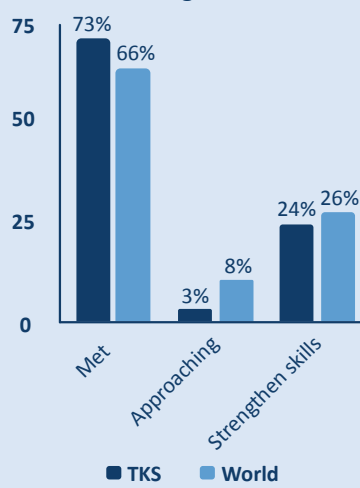


Math benchmarks

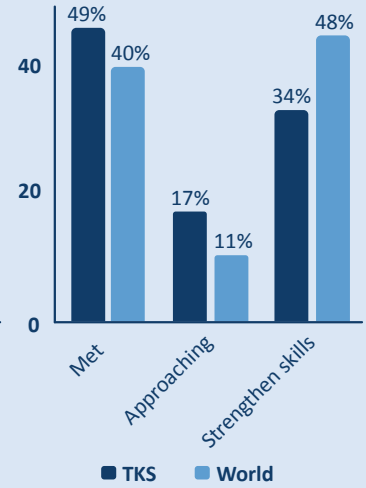

Evidence Based Reading and Writing Benchmarks



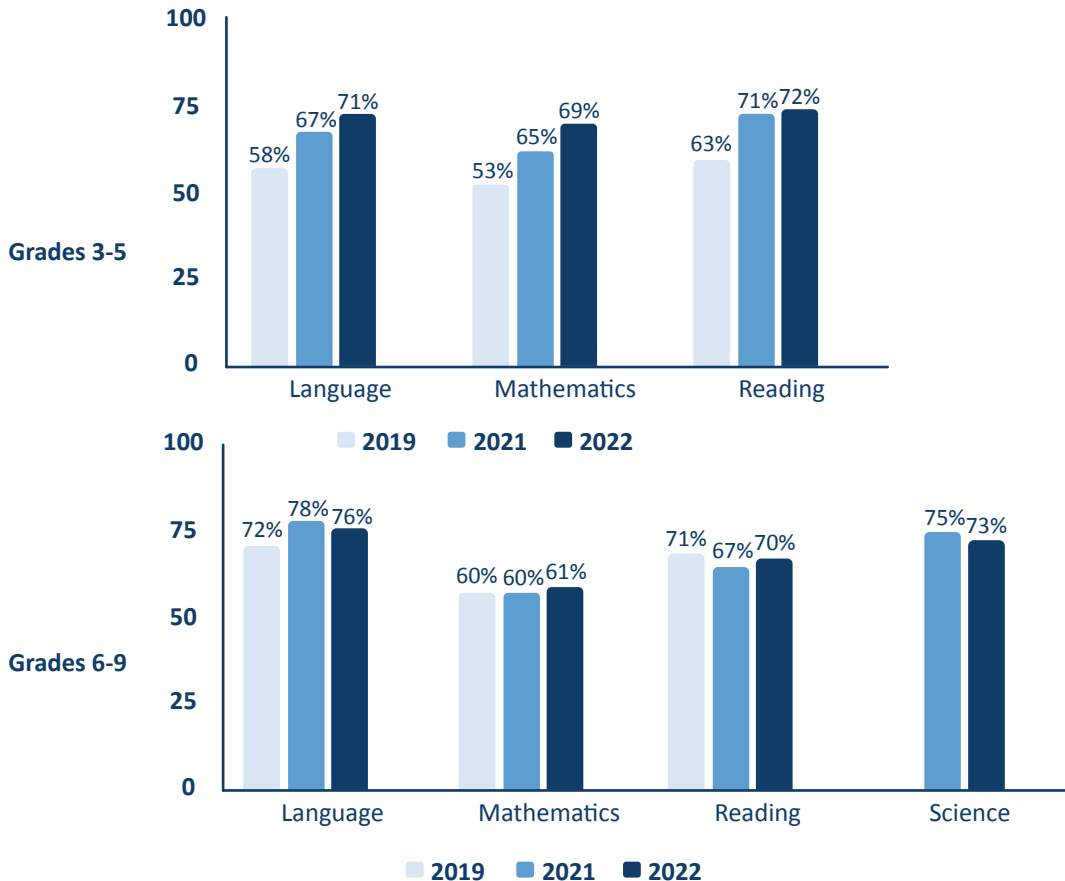

Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)

% of Students above World Average



Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments in reading, math and language use are administered twice a year (Fall and Spring) to students in grade three through ten. MAP assessments are criterion-referenced, meaning they generate a score based on a level of knowledge and skill, not dependent on grade level. Scores are benchmarked against international norms. Numbers exclude students on formal intervention and Individualized Learning Program (Test data from 2020 is absent due to no tests being carried out in second half of the school year due to Covid-19) Science scores are from 2021 onwards as TKS started benchmarking them for Grade 6 to 9 from 2021 onwards.

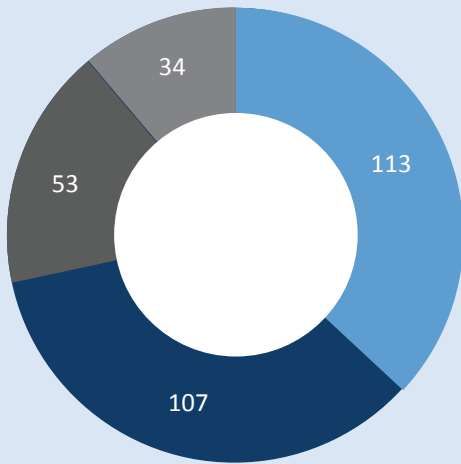
