THE CAMPUS

Our dedicated Early Years Campus in the Harbor District houses a Reggio Emilia inspired environment that is filled with natural light, color and materials to stimulate learning. The buildings include two gymnasiums, a pool, activity rooms, a sustainable garden, libraries and specialized rooms for Art, Music, Arabic and Islamic Studies.

The Elementary, Middle and High Schools are located in the Gardens District of the KAUST community. The environment is purpose built with a design that supports a balanced curriculum including technology-equipped classrooms, science labs, sustainable garden and classroom kitchen, design and technology hub, two libraries, two auditoriums, multiple creative arts spaces, a 25 meter pool, outdoor basketball and tennis courts, a soccer pitch, two gymnasiums, and one field house which includes two competition courts.

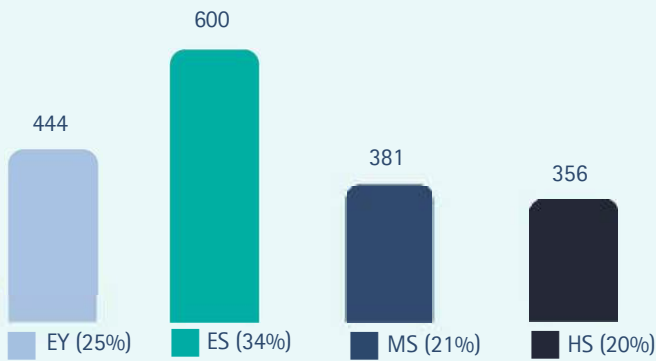

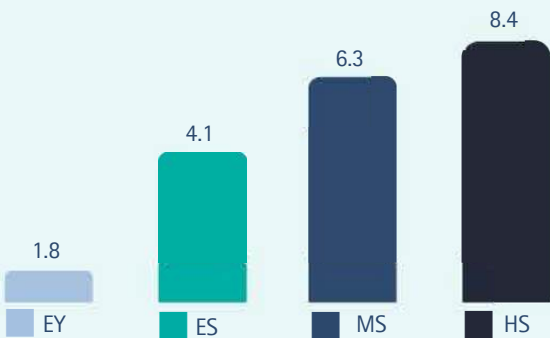

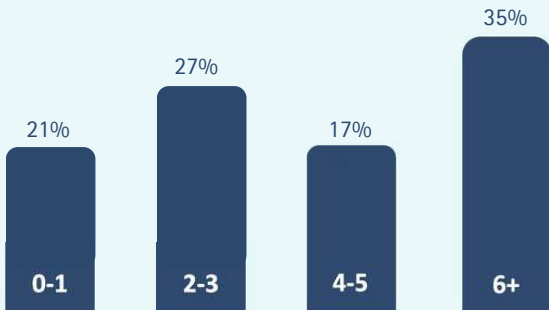

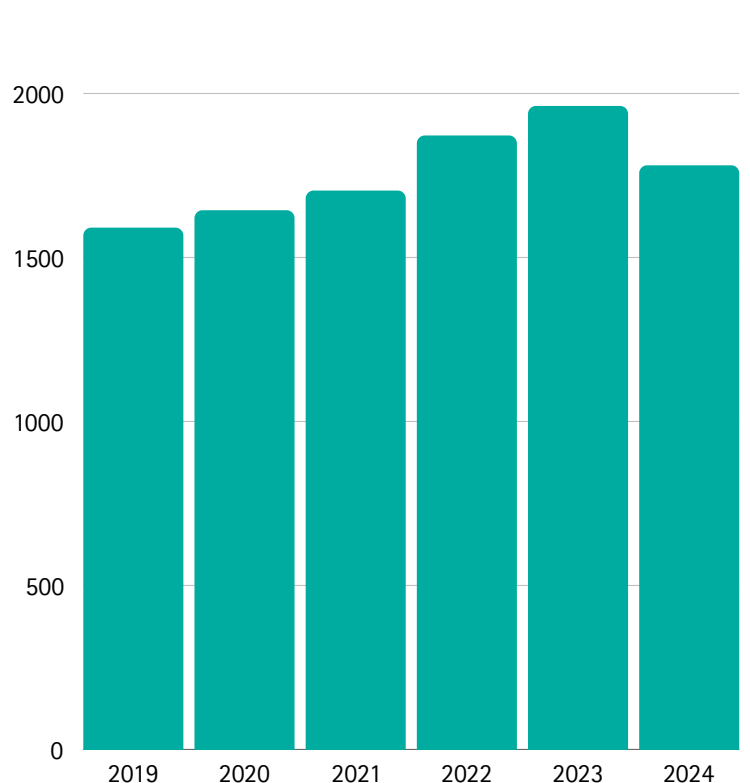
Average Years

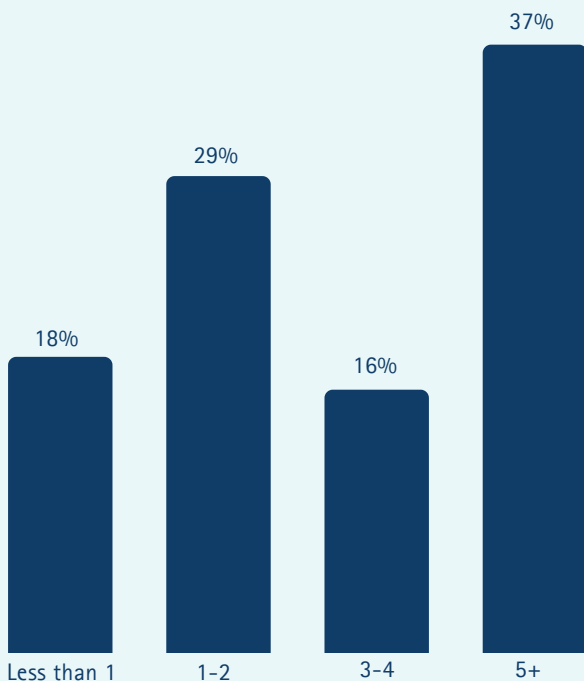

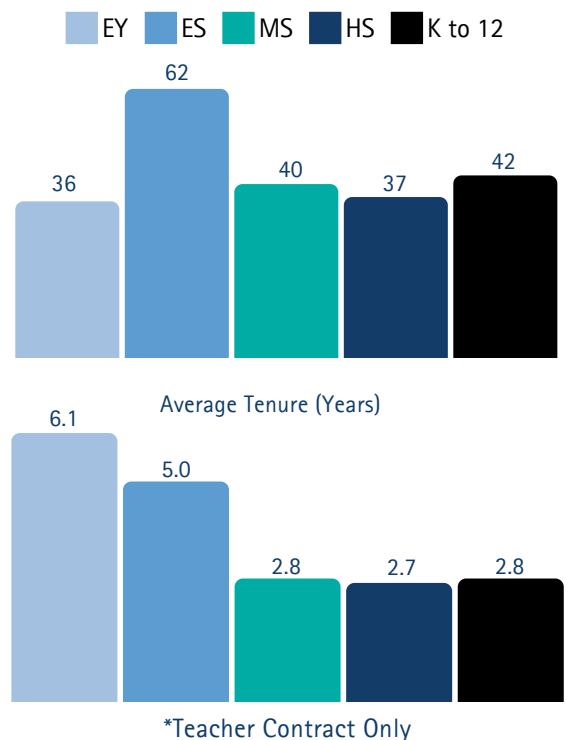

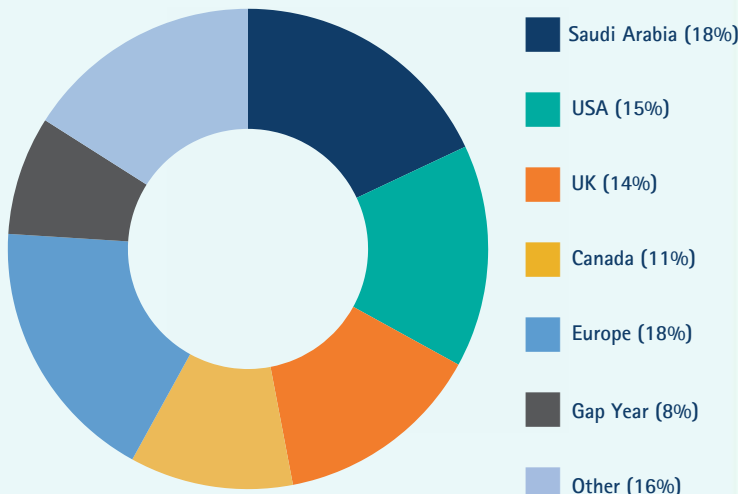

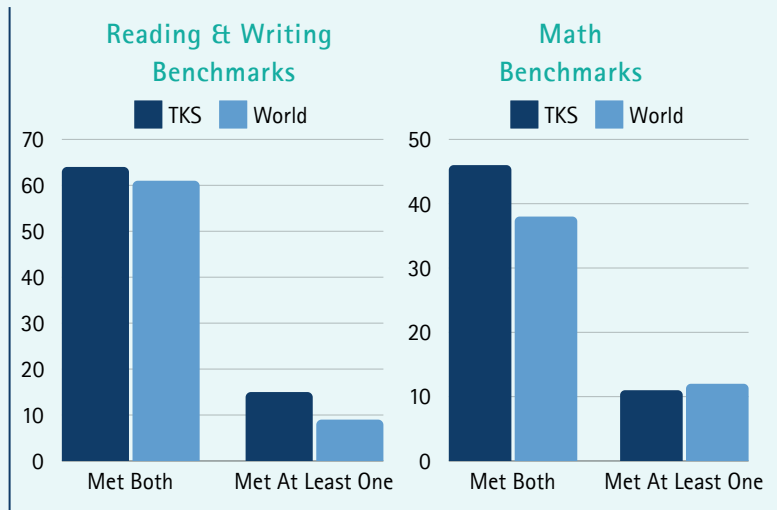

Grade 11 PSAT (87)

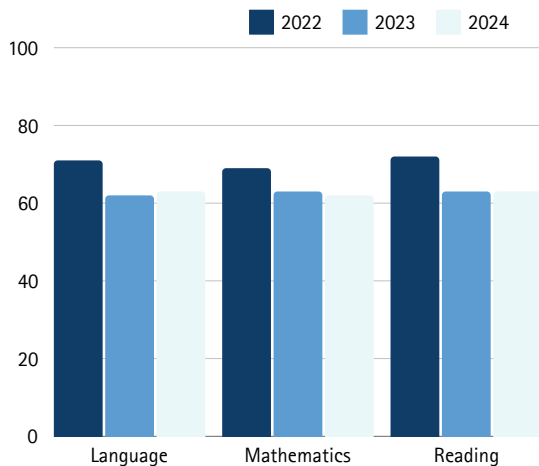

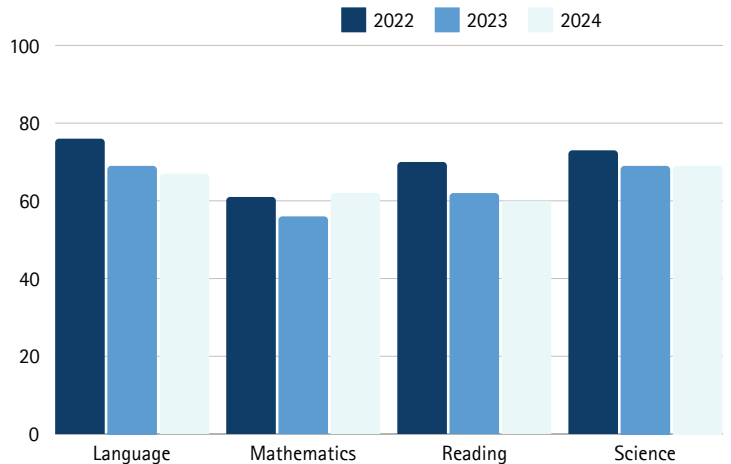
Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)

Grades 3-5

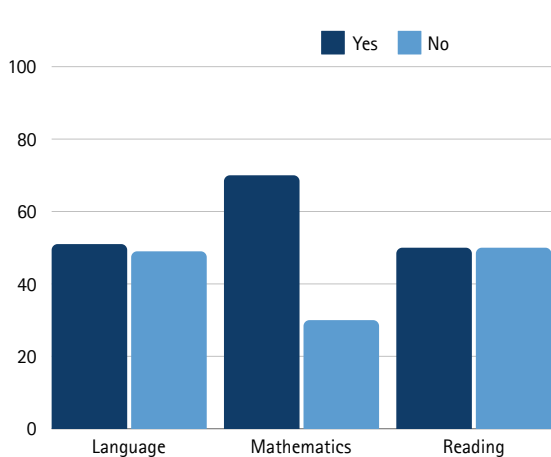


Grades 6-9

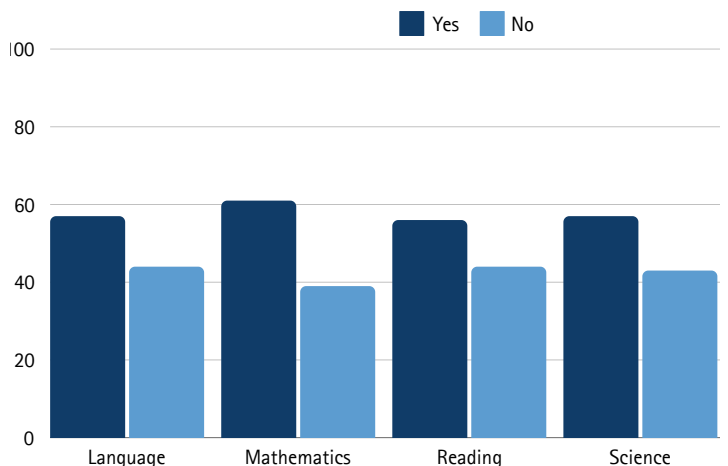


% of Students meeting Growth Targets in 2023-2024

Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments in reading, math and language use are administered twice a year (Fall and Spring) to students in grade three through ten. MAP assessments are criterion-referenced, meaning they generate a score based on a level of knowledge and skill, not dependent on grade level. Scores are benchmarked against international norms. Numbers exclude students on formal intervention and Individualized Learning Program. Includes students receiving Learning and English Language support.
